Objectives

Content

- Introduction to AI and the interplay of IP Rights in AI (maybe hint/contamination/compatibility wrt. data or code & foundation model)
- Practical aspects/strategies of contract drafting for AI Systems
- IP strategies & licensing
- Navigating the ecosystems of AI-related licences (data, software, AI): from Montreal data licenses to (open-)RAILS -- Focus on AI Software Licensing and Contracts
- Data Licensing and IP Rights – from “collecting data to training corpus”
- Algorithms & know-how / processes Trade Secrets in AI: Protection // Proprietary Know-How (NDA, non-competition clauses, responsibility...)
- Contractual Challenges with AI-Generated Content (+contamination/(in-)compatibility (data or code & foundation model)

The seminar will take place on September 27th and 28th, 2024 for a duration of 16 hours (without counting breaks).

Courses will be delivered by leading experts in the field.
