General presentation and specificities

The Center for International Intellectual Property Studies (CEIPI) of the University of Strasbourg is one of the oldest and most renowned teaching and research centers in intellectual property in Europe. Its history is closely linked to the development of intellectual property in France and in the world. Through its diversified and constantly evolving offer, the center, anchored in Strasbourg, has played a significant role in the training of generations of IP professionals in Europe and beyond.

In this context, CEIPI trains specialists in intellectual property law by organizing several training courses. With more than 55 years of experience, high quality teaching tools, a teaching staff composed of specialized academics and recognized practitioners from all national, European and international backgrounds, CEIPI is today recognized in all specialized circles as one of the most important university centers in Europe for teaching and research in intellectual property law. The Center also has a Research Section which carries out fundamental research in the field of intellectual property.

Partnerships

The CEIPI university component has concluded agreements in particular with the European Patent Office (EPO) and with the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), as well as partnerships with various universities or training centers in the United States, Europe and Asia.

Training offer

Within its French Section, CEIPI offers two university degrees in "Patents" and "Trademarks, Designs and Models", preparing engineers, scientists and lawyers for the professional exams of industrial property attorneys, as well as seven professional masters M2 (L.LM equivalent) in "Intellectual Property Law and Valuation of Intangible Assets", "Intellectual property law and international business", "Intellectual property law and data sciences", "Intellectual property law and management", "Industrial property" and a research program "European and international intellectual property law". Since 2019, the creation of 3 new university degrees "European law of distinctive signs and designs", "Artificial intelligence and intellectual property".

Within its International Section, CEIPI is in charge of training future European patent attorneys before the European Patent Office by preparing these young professionals for the European Qualifying Examination (EQE). This training, decentralized in about thirty European cities, is completed by seminars organized in Strasbourg. CEIPI also delivers a university diploma "Patent Litigation in Europe" intended for patent professionals wishing to deepen and update their knowledge of comparative and regional patent law and patent litigation. In addition, CEIPI offers training to senior officials of industrial property offices in developing countries.

Several short courses are also offered, in initial or continuing education, in French or English, throughout the year.
