This programme is aimed at qualified engineers and scientists (professional representatives before the EPO or INPI, examiners), as well as examiners at these offices who wish to deepen their legal knowledge necessary for the evolution of their profession.

This programme trains specialists capable of mastering the complex legal issues of national, European and international law. The aim is to equip participants with the legal skills needed to protect and valorise inventions, trademarks and industrial designs, and to advise companies on defending their titles as well as handling patent litigation before the Unified Patent Court (UPC).

This workshop addresses the unique legal challenges associated with the development of artificial intelligence (AI) applications, particularly in relation to intellectual property and contracts. It aims to bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical applications through a combination of teaching sessions and practical exercises. Participants will gain indepth knowledge and practical skills to deal with AI contracts. The workshop follows the lifecycle of an AI project, covering critical stages such as data collection, model training, partnerships and deployment. It will conclude with a series of negotiation exercises. Each session includes presentations, contract drafting exercises and reviews with feedback from experienced professionals. By the end of the course, participants will be able to effectively manage the legal and contractual issues associated with the development and deployment of AI.
