Bio :

Alexander Grigoriev, citizen of the Russian Federation.
President of the Eurasian Patent Office since February 2004.

Dr. Grigoriev holds an engineer's diploma from the Moscow Textile Institute (1969), diploma in economics and international law from the USSR Academy of Foreign Trade (1979), special patent diplomas from the USSR Central Institute for Upgrade Training of the Managers and Specialists in Patenting (1974) and the Center for International Industrial Property Studies of the Robert Schuman Strasbourg University (CEIPI) (1992).

Dr. Grigoriev began his career in the USSR Scientific Research Institute for the State Patent Examination (VNIIGPE) in 1971, worked as an official of the USSR State Committee for Inventions and Discoveries and the Committee of the Russian Federation for Patents and Trademarks from 1979 to 1995.

From the establishment of the Eurasian Patent Office of the Eurasian Patent Organization (December 1995) till February 2004 - Vice-President of the Eurasian Patent Office.

In 2009 Dr. Grigoriev was reelected for the second 6-year period as the President of the EAPO, starting February 2010.

Doctor of Law (PhD).

Full Member of the Russian Academy of Natural Sciences.

One of the creators of the Eurasian Patent Convention.

Author of several scientific publications in industrial property.
